

Blue Light Guidelines

In order to equip your personal vehicle with a “Blue Courtesy Light”, the Chief must first issue you a “Blue Light” cards.

- A Blue Light card may be revoked at any time for any reason.
- A Blue Light is ONLY a courtesy light and as such DOES NOT give you the right to violate and Vehicle and Traffic Laws:
 - You MUST obey ALL speed limits
 - You must obey all traffic lights even if the driver in an adjacent lane gives you the right to go
 - You MUST obey all traffic signs i.e., One Way signs, No Parking signs, etc.
 - You MAY not cross double solid lines in the highway or single solid lines on your side of the road
 - You MAY NOT cut through parking lots, gas stations or private property to avoid traffic lights or signs

- A Blue Light is used on the way to a call. It MAY NOT be used returning to the station from a completed call.

When responding to a call you are required to report to the station. You may stop at the location of a call if you pass it in route to the station and you are able to provide some technical assistance such as that provided by a Certified EMT.

When entering the WSLFD property you must proceed with caution giving the right of way to any emergency vehicles on the apron or ready to enter/exit the apron.
